It is time for the annual appeal to support our Planned Giving scheme.

A glance at the donut graphs alongside will tell you that we do need your support. As reported in our 2016 Accounts, our income is down and our underlying expenses are up.

You will also see that almost 75% of our income is from the Planned Giving scheme and associated Gift Aid. It underpins all of the work we do within the Parish (paying for the clergy, the upkeep of the Churches, the upkeep of the parish houses and keeping the Parish ticking), as well as helping outside the Parish (supporting poorer Parishes and funding our Mission giving).

If we want these works to continue, we have to be confident that we will have enough income to meet all of the costs.

If you are not in the Planned Giving scheme, please join. If you are in the scheme, please think carefully about your renewal.

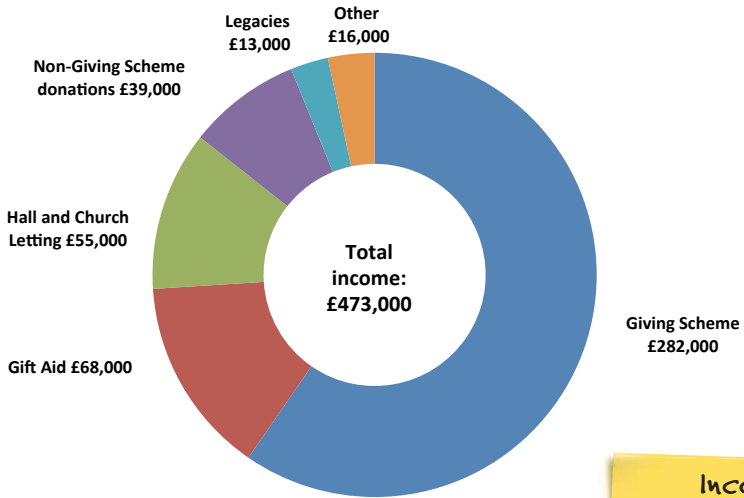

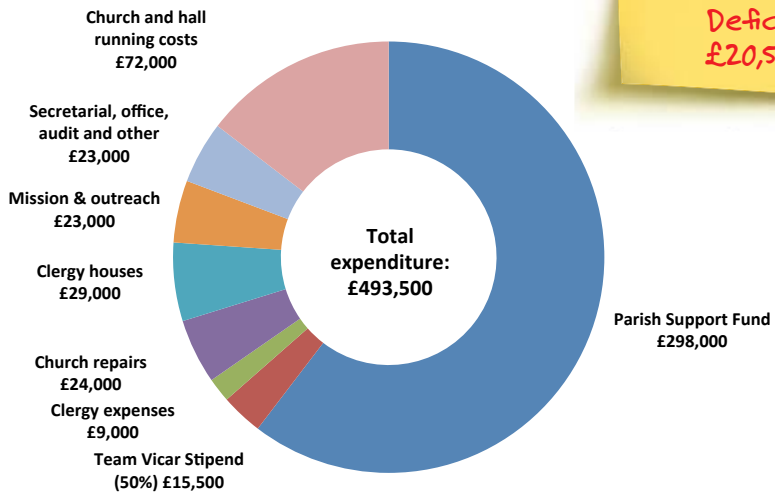

What should I do now?

1 Pray, reflect and decide upon what you wish to give for 2017–18.

We'd like you to give through the scheme, so we can plan and manage our finances. Some of you may have received a bonus or a windfall this year. Why not make an additional one-off payment?

Equally, the economic climate may have treated you harshly and payments may be difficult or impossible. This is not a problem – the church is for everyone!

2 Instruct your bank to arrange the Standing Order (on-line, by letter or visit). We will assume you have instructed the bank unless you tell us otherwise. All the information you need is on the form.

3 Tell your representative what you have done (by email, by posting the Response Form using the enclosed addressed envelope or by placing it in the box in your Church).

4 If you have not already done so in the past, complete the **Gift Aid** declaration form if your giving will be eligible and return to your representative.

5 Reviewing your will? Please consider making a gift to the parish.
